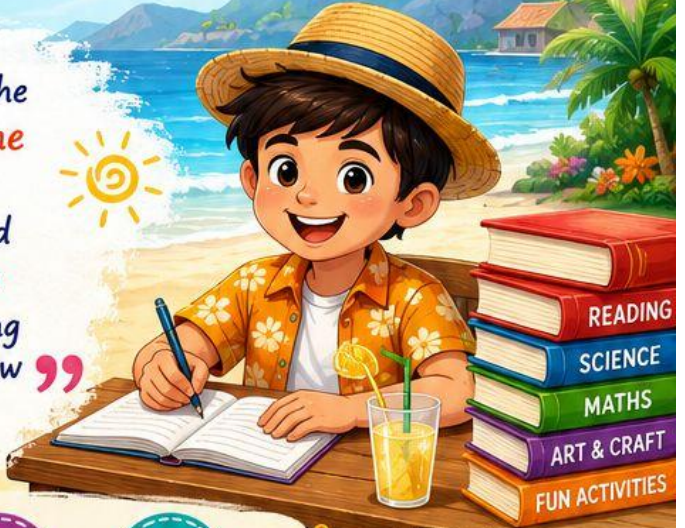

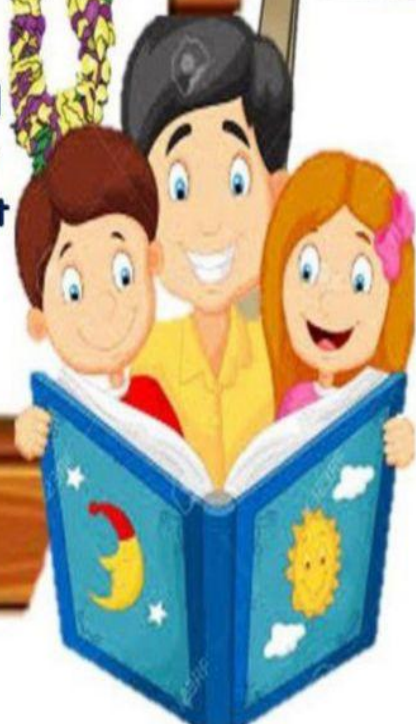
Summer Holiday
