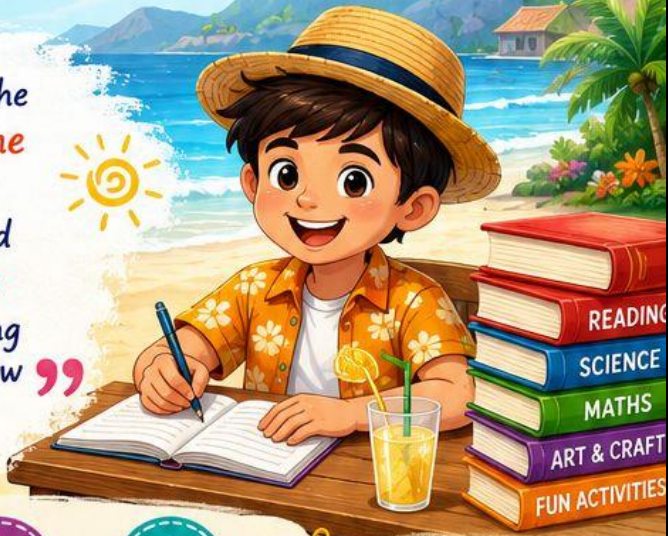

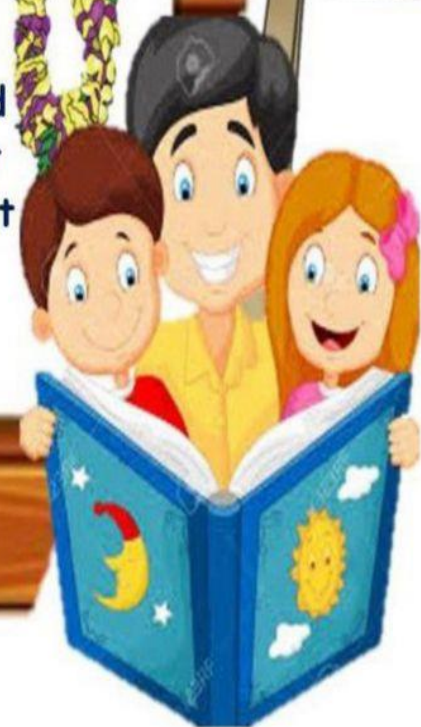
Summer Holiday
